



Letter of Intent for International Collaboration

This letter signals support for exploring engagement opportunities between the Brazilian Association of Higher Education (hereafter "ABMES") and the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education (hereafter "OISE'), University of Toronto. We recognize the potential for synergy and mutual benefit through such a collaboration.

ABMES, as a representative of private higher education institutions in Brazil, plays a vital role in shaping the landscape of education in that country. OISE, affiliated with the University of Toronto, has a global reputation for its commitment to innovative education research and pedagogical practices.

While the specifics of our collaboration are open for discussion and will depend on shared interests and priorities, we envision potential areas of collaboration that may include:

- Education Exchanges: Facilitating student, staff, and faculty exchange programs to promote cross-cultural learning experiences and enrich our educational communities.

 that advance knowledge and innovation in education, with a focus on addressing shared
 challenges and opportunities.
- Joint Projects: Exploring opportunities to collaborate on specific projects or initiatives that leverage our respective strengths.

Both parties are committed to fostering engagement opportunities based on mutual respect, transparency, and shared values. The ABMES visit to OISE, **October 10 2023**, is a first step in identifying our mutual interests and our joint commitment to explore potential collaborative projects in the weeks and months ahead.
