#### 2022-2025

Cohorts 5-7 delivered by ICL supported by strategic partners.




#### **Ambition**

  - o employed by a social care provider or local authority working across health and care services in England.


#### The programme is aimed at:

PG Dip in Digital Health Leadership 2024 - 2025






