## I The China-Korea LEADership Program

- The China-Korea LEADership Program is a 20-day academic exchange program for undergraduate/graduate students from China and Korea.
- The program consists of four main programs of “Learning”, “Experience”, “Argumentation” and “Discovery”. Participants are given chances to listen to lectures from prominent scholars, to go on field trips, and to participate in discussions and autonomous research and group work in order to understand the issues that define the future of China and Korea.

## 2 NEWDAY ( Nansen East-West Dialogue Academy)

- NEWDAY is an annual summer course that provides a platform for university students from **East Asia** and the **Nordic region** to engage in **dialogues** on current global challenges, to learn from each other, and to foster harmonious relations between prospective future leaders.
- The academy provide a unique opportunity for the students to learn about and debate contemporary issues based on acquired knowledge of great **Eastern and Western thinkers and humanitarians**.



### 3. BRICS Program Summer School

- ✓ From **2014 to 2019**, the BRICS Summer School has been successfully held for **six semesters**, with a total of **182 outstanding young students** from the BRICS countries.
- ✓ Two themes - **“BRICS Co-operation and Global Governance”** and **“China Politics and Diplomacy”**.
